Wrestlers prepare to and win 21st straight SLT NEWS RELEASE November 1, 2012

The Wadsworth wrestling program produced one State Tournament finalist with Nick Tavanello earning his third straight individual State Championship, beating Garrett Gray, Oregon Clay 6-5UTB

In addition, the Grizzlies finished 11-4 in dual matches, Sectional Runnersup, 4th in the District, qualified 6 individuals to State, with three state placers, including State Champion: Nick Tavanello. State runner-up: Kagan Squire and 7th place Christian Baughman. These accomplishments helped lead the Grizzlies to State 7th place finish; thus, giving the wrestling program 18 times in the top 10 of the State.

After completing one of the toughest schedules in team history and winning its 20th consecutive Suburban League Championship, area teams may wonder if the Grizzlies will have anything left in the year 2012-13. This year only Mathias Zollinger returns as a State Qualifier, leading the the rest of the 2012-13 team to begin the quest of continued dominance of the Suburban League and bring home another Banner from the 16,000 seat Schottenstein Center in Columbus February 28, March 1 and 2 at the OHSAA State Championship.

The nucleus of the 2012-13 team has worked extremely hard in the off-season, with individual wrestlers posting more than 200 total hours of lifting weights, wrestling at open mats on Thursday nights, and attending summer camps, especially the Jeff Jordan State Champ camp and Kent State team camps, and competing nationally in the Junior Duals in Oklahoma and the Cadet and Junior National Tournaments in Fargo, North Dakota.

The future looks promising with a strong 9th grade team. They are a determined group with a great deal of potential. In fact, some freshmen will see varsity action. This is the 19th ninth grade class with Youth League experience at Firestone High School, and the entire state has indeed noticed the difference.

Over 40 enthusiastic 7th and 8th graders have turned out for the Middle School team. They are coached by Larry Kaufman and assistant coach Josh Hendricks. The coaches continue to do a great job molding and developing young talent that feeds the high school. They have won several tournaments over the past years and have developed a winning attitude and a very strong work ethic, earning the reputation as one of the best Junior High programs in the state. As ateam they qualified to the OAC Junior High State Dual Meet, finishing 4th while Brock Swartzbaugh, Cody Surrat, Kyle Ellis, Joey Baughman, Brandon Baughman, and Noah Baughman, represented Wadsworth at the OAC Junior High State Individual Tournament.

Our Youth Program has over 105 members and a strong coaching nucleus headed again by Todd Baughman and a multitude of dad coaches. Our treasurer Matt Swartzbaugh continues to help organize and develop the inner workings of the program heads up the rest of the mom and dads for a variety of projects. John Gramuglia has been a teacher and coach for 32 years. He is currently teaching journalism and is adviser for the school newspaper at Wadsworth High School. As head wrestling coach of Wadsworth High School for the past 28 years, John Gramuglia has produced a career dual meet record of 290-65-1 and 20 straight Suburban League Championships, 21 overall. His teams have amassed 14 Sectional titles, 2 District titles, and 10 District runners-up.

Over the past eighteen years, his teams have placed in the top 10 of State 17 times and the top 5 five out of the last seven years. He has coached 255 District qualifiers, 107 State qualifiers, 67 state placers and 13 state champions.

He earned a Bachelor's degree from John Carroll University where he wrestled for Tony DeCarlo and has earned a Master's Degree from the University of Akron in Sports Administration.

He and his lovely wife, Cindy of thirty-one years have a 27 year old son Sean and 19 year old daughter Dana.
